

NORDIC ROSES 2024 Pre-tour to Finland

Pre-tour Programme

June 25

Arrival in Stockholm. You will be greeted and taken to the harbour for departure by ferry to Turku in Finland in the evening. The ferry departs at 8.pm. In the harbour You will be met by Your host from the Finnish Rose Society that will accompany you during the Finland visit. On board we are accomodated in comfortable two-person cabins. We enjoy a three-course get together dinner. The nights are bright at this time of the year so there is ample time to enjoy the scenery of the worlds most beautiful archipelago.

June 26

Early breakfast on board. Arriving in Turku harbour we are met by our tour bus. It will take us to the botanical garden of Turku University where we get an introduction to the Finnish flora and especially roses that can manage our winters. This is followed up by a visit to the small Masku rosarium that has specialized in preserving found roses from different parts of Finland. We also have an introduction to the history of Turku city in the Aboa Vetus Museum for archeology and contemporary art before moving to our hotel Majvik in the vicinity of Helsinki.

June 27

We start the day with a visit to a private garden whose owners have been devoted to growing roses for a few decades. We enjoy lunch and a short walk in the park at the beautifully situated Wohls gård. After lunch it is time for a round trip in central Helsinki where we can see both the old historical center around the Senate Square and the modern new center in front of the Parliament house.

A relaxing walk in Meilahti Rosarium that focuses on hardy Finnish roses rounds up the day before transport to Tampere and our hotel there.

June 28

The day starts in Hataanpää arboretum and its gem, the rose garden where we can see both hardy shrub roses and modern (not so hardy) roses. A round trip in Tampere city before lunch in museal surroundings. Transport to Visuvesi and a small private garden situated beautifully at the lakeside. After a short stop-over we enter the 115 years old steamboat Tarjanne that takes us to Ruovesi along the poets route. Bus transport to Lapua.

June 29

Morning visit to Jokilaakso Garden Center. Jokilaakso Garden Centre's pride and joy is its area of edible plants, the Herb Plot. It is one of Finland's largest show areas of edible plants. It also has quite a few typical Finnish shrub roses in addition to some thousand other plants. Bus transport to Vaasa for lunch. At last, some hours free in the afternoon before moving to the Kvarken World Heritage site in the archipelago. The day is rounded off with a dinner at the restaurant Bernys in the archipelago.

June 30

This last day in Finland starts with a visit to the small city rosarium in Vaasa where You can see many of the specific Finnish shrub roses. We visit Stundars homestead museum which is one of the best in Finland. After lunch visit to a private garden with more than 500

different roses in a small space. The focus of the owner has been to find roses that can survive and flourish in spite of harsh winters, but also to find ways to get not so hardy roses to survive and bloom despite the unfavorable climate.

On our way to Turku we stop at the Ahlström's historical industrial area in Noormarkku. In the evening we board the ferry back to Stockholm.

July 1

Arrival in Stockholm early in the morning we are met by the local hosts and taken for sightseeing.
